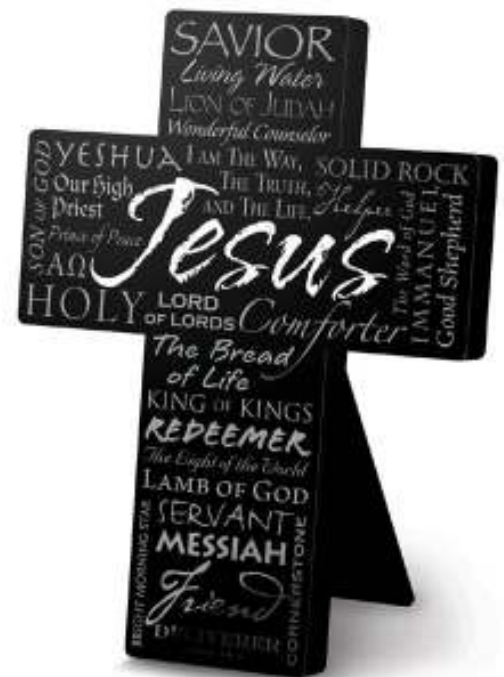

GOD IS ABOVE ALL by Dr Bruce Woolard

To Assyria, the God of Judah was no different to the gods of the other nations. They reckoned that the other nations' gods couldn't rescue them from the Assyrians. Why should Judah's God be any different? They made out that God was just another "little god." The people of Judah knew better. That is why they remained silent. They knew what would happen to those who taunt and insult God.

Today it is the norm to compare the one and only Almighty God with other gods. Apart from the "New Age" movement, which deliberately propagates this theory, there are many other people who believe we all worship the same God. 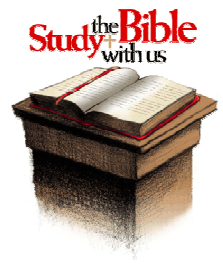
